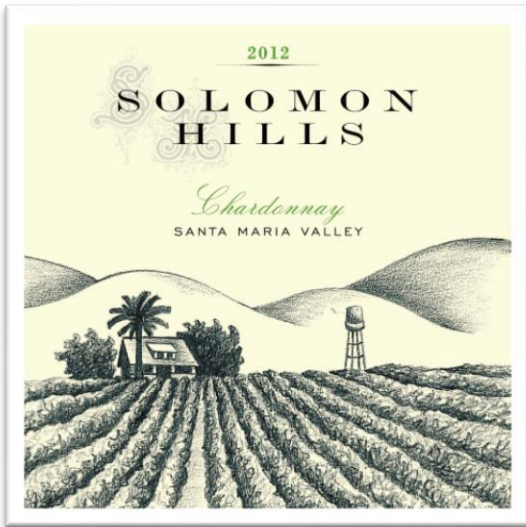

WINEMAKER NOTES

Hand harvested at night, and whole cluster pressed. It was then barrel fermented with native yeast and malolactic fermentations. Aging was sur lie for 16 months in French oak; 28% new. This wine was bottled unfiltered.

Beautiful aromas of passion fruit, ginger, and flint on the nose. This Solomon Hills has bright acidity that becomes very rich and round on the mid palate and finish.
