WINEMAKER NOTES

Hand harvested at night, and fermented with native yeast and malolactic fermentations. Then aged for 16 months in French oak; 20% new. This wine was bottled unfiltered.

Pinot Noir like aromatics on the nose with raspberry, red licorice, black cherries, and wild herbs. The wine's rich entry is satiny and fruit dominated, but builds with supple tannins and a long graceful finish.
