WINEMAKER NOTES

Hand-harvested at night and fermented with native yeast and malolactic fermentation. Aged 16 months in 600-liter French oak puncheons; 40% new. This wine was bottled unfiltered and unfiltered.

TASTING NOTES

As is traditional from this Pacific Ocean facing block, the Syrah has beautiful aromas of lavender and honeysuckle alongside the earth. Followed by spiciness of tobacco, cacao, blueberries, sage, and chocolate on the palate. The black pepper spice is currently hidden by youth but is certain to develop with a few years in bottle. Open today and enjoy the fresh fruit and flowers or age ten years and beyond as this Syrah continues to develop nuance and complexity.
