#### VINEYARD SITE

VYD AREA | 600-900 FT. ELEVATION. 16 MILES FROM THE PACIFIC OCEAN.

SOILS | ELDER AND CHAMISE SHALY LOAMS WITH PLESANTON SANDY LOAM. THE VINEYARD HAS A GREAT DIVERSITY OF SOILS CONTAINING LIMESTONE, SHALE, UPLIFTED MARINE VOLCANICS AND LOAM.

## WINEMAKER NOTES

Hand-harvested at night and whole-cluster pressed. This wine was then barrel fermented using native yeast and malolactic fermentation. Aging was sur lie for 16 months in French oak; 45% new. This wine was bottled unfined and unfiltered.

## TASTING NOTES

Classically Bien Nacido, with aromas of straw and chamomile interspersed with wet stone and lemon peel. Beautiful mineral notes balance out fresh fruit and tropical flowers on the palate. This wine has the characteristically firm structure of the 2021 vintage combined with the richness and viscosity that ties it all together. We expect this Chardonnay will age gracefully for at least eight to ten years.
