WINEMAKER NOTES

Hand-harvested at night and fermented with native yeast and malolactic fermentation. Aged 16 months in 600-liter French oak puncheons; 45% new. This wine was bottled unfiltered and unfiltered.

TASTING NOTES

Planted to Riesling in 1973 and grafted to Syrah in the 1980's, this is truly one of the most unique Syrah blocks in the entire world. The vines are pruned overhead and allowed to sprawl towards the ground. The resulting atmosphere is reminiscent of a stand of redwoods as the dense vine canopy and native grasses on the vineyard floor absorb all sound. Leather, tobacco, and grilled meats blend with boysenberry and cardamon on the nose. The palate has unbelievable density with clove and white pepper giving way to supple tannins and great length. This wine has a raw power that will take decades to unwind.
